## CURRENT COVID 19 ARRANGEMENTS

- If there has been a positive case of COVID19 within the class you will be notified
- **In order to reduce risk of further positive cases please arrange for your child to undertake daily LFD testing for seven days.**
- Whilst your child is **negative** they do not need to self-isolate and should continue to attend school
- If your child tests positive on an LFD test, they should isolate immediately for 10 days but they do not need to get a PCR (from Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> January 2022 in England, people who receive a positive LFD result won't be required to take a confirmatory PCR test. This is a temporary measure while rates remain high)
- However, if you develop one of the 3 main COVID-19 symptoms you should stay at home, self-isolate and take a PCR test
- If they get a negative LFD on days 6 and 7 (24 hours apart) they can then return to school on day 7
- Continue to isolate for the full 10 days if they continue to test positive.

10		Isolation ends – no test required
