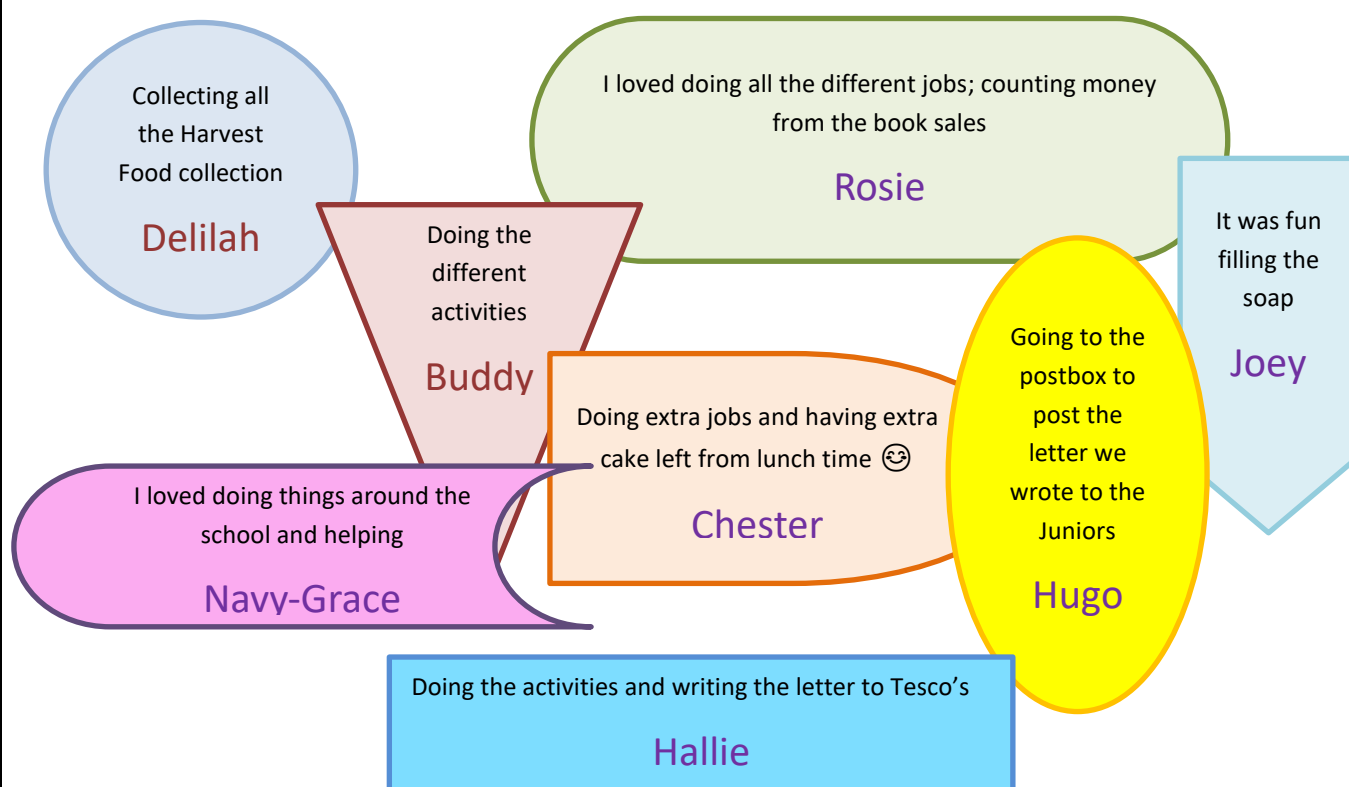

Minutes

- We have in the past 5 weeks carried out lots of different task:
 1. We looked round the school to see the things we think needed to be changed, things that are unsafe and things we might need to raise money for. We made a list to be pinned in the office, we talked to Mrs Walker who looks after all the money, what we might be able to afford or do to get more money.
 2. We checked the outside play sheds to see what needed to be done to make playtime more exciting. The sheds had lots of different toys but we decided they need to be organised.
 3. We helped Mrs Nicholson check the school toilets for cleanliness, check the soap dispensers and toilet paper holders. We then filled up the soap if it was needed and the paper. We all agreed it was fun to be the caretaker for a little while.
 4. We helped collect all the Harvest food for the Food bank, putting it into bags and boxes so it can be transported to St George's Church Food Hub.
 5. We wrote a letter to the Junior School Council to introduce ourselves and tell them some of the things we do. We also asked them to write back and tell us the things they might do as a School Council. We took our letter to the post box and posted it.

6. We wrote a letter to Tesco's to say thank you for the food they gave us to help Year 2 make healthy sandwiches. We will be delivering it to Tesco's in the new term with the new school council.
 7. We removed some of the hall Parquet floor which has been down since 1970 so almost 63 years, we all removed a token piece ready for half term when the hall will have new floor. Mrs Nicholson was very excited!
 8. We had Scholastics visiting book fair to raise funds so we could get some new books for the school. We counted the money and we will wait for Mrs Daly to tell us how many books were ordered on line so we know the final amount.
- Mrs Nicholson presented us with a certificate, a small gift and some sweets, to say thank you for being part of the School Council. We will now need to tell the next class representative what they need to do.

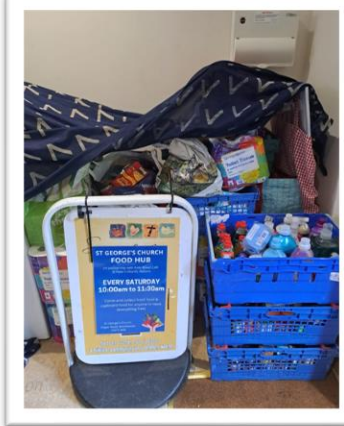

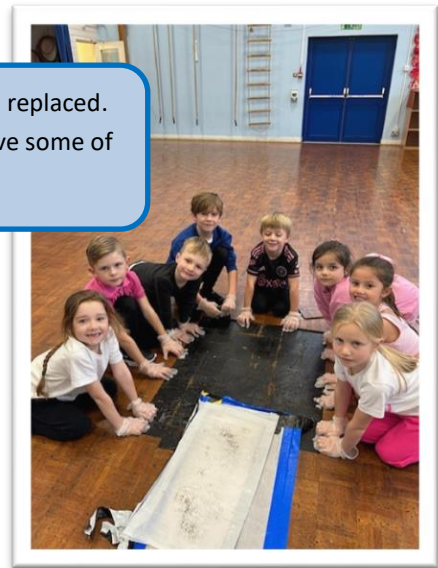
